The mission of Inspiration Hills is to provide a set-apart place in nature where people of all ages can grow in awareness of God and deepen their commitment to Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior, so that in all aspects of Christian life we might continue the work of Jesus Christ, peacefully, simply, together.

HOW DO I REGISTER?

1. Pick your camp date/dates*.
2. Fill out the attached registration form and have your camper sign it (Church of the Brethren members please forward your form to your church's Camp Representative and skip step 3).
3. Make checks payable to Inspiration Hills and mail your completed registration form and fees to: Summer Camp Registration, Inspiration Hills, 4819 West Easton Road, Burbank, Ohio 44214
4. You are done; get ready for a great week at camp! Confirmation information will be sent upon receipt of registration.

*Registrations are accepted on a first come-first serve basis, determined by space available and counselor limitations. Rules for acceptance and participation in the program are the same for everyone regardless of race, color, sex, handicap, religion, or creed. Inspiration Hills reserves the right to cancel a camp by June 1st if the minimum number of campers is not met. Your camper will then be moved to their second choice of camps and you will be notified immediately.

DISCOUNTS

Take \$30 off of the regular price of camp by registering before April 15, 2010. You will receive a multiple child discount of \$10 per additional sibling registered.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Your church congregation may pay a portion of the camp fee. Please check with your church's camp representative. Scholarships are also available through the camp for families needing financial assistance. Requests for scholarships should be made in writing and accompany the registration form along with a note from your pastor stating the need.

CANCELLATIONS

Cancellations received 30 days prior to your camp date will receive a full refund minus a \$20 processing fee. Cancellations received less than 30 days prior to your camp date will receive ½ of the registration fee minus a \$20 processing fee. If a child does not arrive for camp, all registration fees are forfeited.

PERSONAL CONDUCT INFORMATION

Church camp is about living in Christian Community. In an attempt to provide an atmosphere where children can live together in that community, the campers are expected to: participate and cooperate in activities, respect one another, use no profanity, wear modest and appropriate clothing*, and have a behavior that is not disruptive to the program. The camp reserves the right to send a camper home that is unable to function within these guidelines.
